

Toastmaster of the Year

- All Toastmasters except for District Officers and Club Presidents are eligible to apply for this award.
- Nominees must be members in good standing of clubs in good standing.
- Toastmasters must nominate themselves by submitting their own applications. A Toastmaster may only apply once, regardless of how many clubs he or she belongs to.
- Nominations including name, address, phone number, home club name and club number are due to the prior Toastmaster year's District Governor by July 15. Dual members must choose one and only one club to represent on their applications.
- Applicants may include all points earned as a member of any club in District 36.
- All point claims must be supported with names, dates, places, and documentation when submitted for consideration.
- The District Governor (by then the IPDG) will announce a winner in early August and submit the winner's name to Toastmaster's International.
- The IPDG will present the award to the winner at the Fall District Conference in November.
- All decisions by the IPDG are final.

Toastmaster of the Year nominees will be given points for the following Criteria:
