You can save some time by directly requesting that a duplicate proxy is mailed. The duplicate proxy will be sent to the Club President of record, so it is important that the President's name and mailing address are correct at the World Headquarters website. Go to www.toastmasters.org -> Member Profile to check the address. The club's password is needed to confirm the President's name. Send a message with club #, club name, and president's name and mailing address to: duplicateproxies@toastmasters.org .

When the envelope comes, open it, sign the card which has the 'A' on it, and mail it to Sandra. My address should be pre-printed on card. You will need first class postage, and you might want to put the proxy card into an envelope. In some cases, we can arrange a passing of the proxy card individually.
